- Media captioning
- Sign language interpretation

- Auxiliary aids digital voice recorders, Livescribe Smartpens, anti-glare computer screen filters
- Copies of instructors' PowerPoint slides
- Permission to use laptop in class to take notes
- Note taking assistance through volunteer students
- Use of formula note cards on math exams
- Use of a calculator on math exams
- Preferential seating
- Take breaks as needed during class
