1. Overall GPA in all college course work
2. Average in course work at UCO
3. Courses in English Composition, Fundamentals of Speech, Professional Education, and area of specialization (major) "C
4. Proficiency in foreign languageNovice 4 level (May be taken at OSU-OKC.)
5. Admission to Teacher Education and Student Teaching 2.75 overall GPA OR 3.00 GPA in the last 30 hours completed.

All admission and certification requirements for teacher preparation programs can be found in the UCO Undergraduate Catalog.

Competency in a foreign language can be met through competence in a native language, a college semester of a foreign language with a "C" or better, two years of the same language in high school with a "B" average.

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include minimums of:

- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
- 60 hours from baccalaureate granting institutions
