

ATI-TEAS Content Information

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS), administered by the Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI), is a pre-entry examination used to assess the fundamental academic knowledge and skills of individuals applying to health science programs, such as OSU-OKC Cardiovascular Sonography A.A.S. degree or OSU-OKC Radiologic Technology A.A.S. degree. The ATI-TEAS is an overall measure of general academic education.

ATI-TEAS

There are 170 multiple choice questions; however, 20 are unscored pretest questions. Questions are divided into four main subcategories:
