Benefits Value Advisor: A Benefits Value Advisor can help you assess your options for receiving care. These advisors can give you a cost estimate, assist in the pre-certification of your benefits and help you understand how to maximize your benefits.

Before you receive a non-emergent CAT/CT scan, MRI, colonoscopy, endoscopy, back/spinal surgery, knee surgery, shoulder surgery, hip replacement or other joint replacement surgery, consult the BVA to save \$100 in fees associated with those procedures. To access the BVA, call the customer service number on the back of your Blue Cross Blue Shield member ID card and ask to speak to a Benefits Value Advisor.

Using the BVA will help you save money by using a provider who will deliver the same treatment at a lower cost. When the OSU/A&M health plan saves money, so do you.

Blue Distinction Specialty Care Services: Plan participants have access to specialty care facilities. Should you utilize a Blue Distinction Specialty Care facility, your plan will pay for 90% of the facility charges for cardiac care, knee and hip replacement and spine surgery after meeting your deductible.
