## **Important Opportunity for Your Retirement**

The OSU/A&M Voluntary 403(b) Retirement Plan and the OSU/A&M Voluntary 457(b) Deferred Compensation Retirement Plan offer all OSU/A&M employees an opportunity to set aside retirement savings on a voluntary basis. All employees paid through the OSU/A&M payroll system, including student and temporary employees, are eligible to participate regardless of classification, percent of time employed or length of appointment. Additional information about these plans is available here.

Elected contributions are deducted from an employee's regular paycheck on a pre-tax basis (federal and state withholdings but not FICA), or you can contribute on an after-tax basis with the Roth plans. The minimum contribution is \$15 per month for each plan. The maximum annual tax-deferred contribution limit is established by Internal Revenue Service regulations. For 2025, that limit is \$23,500 for employees under 50. Employees 50-59 and 64+ years of age may contribute \$31,000; and employees 60-63 years of age can contribute \$34,750. You may contribute the maximum amount for both a 403(b) plan and a 457(b) plan.


TIAA is the sole approved provider. To begin contributions, change the amount of contributions or cancel participation, please complete a <u>Salary Reduction Agreement form</u>. Full-time, benefits-eligible employees can enroll and/or make changes online through <u>Benefitplace</u> at any time throughout the year. Your elections will become effective no earlier than the first of the month following when the agreement form is received by human resources.

Benefits-eligible employees are enrolled in either OTRS or the Alternate Retirement Plan offered by TIAA. The university does not contribute to either the 403(b) or 457(b) plans. Employees can see contributions by reviewing their pay stub at <a href="mailto:my.okstate.edu">my.okstate.edu</a>.



## **Annual Staff Evaluations Coming This May**

It's almost time for Annual Staff Evaluations. Remember that all employees are required to participate in two professional development training courses per year. The dates of review are May 1, 2024, through April 30, 2025. To view a copy of your Talent Management System (TMS) training, go to talent.okstate.edu, log in with your O-key, and click on *Completed Transcript*.



You should see any professional development you have completed on your transcript providing it was submitted to HR. To export your training list or to add external training, click on the 3 horizontal dots toward the top right of your transcript page.
