PERIODICALS

Print: The Periodical Index, found throughout the Library, lists over 50 nursing periodical titles (see page 5 in back section of book). Periodicals and journals are shelved alphabetically by title.

Electronic Access: The following databases provide professional level journal articles. Both subject and keyword searching are available with indexes geared to the terminology of the health field.

Within EBSCOhost:

- **CINAHL Complete** offers an index, abstracts, and fulltext articles for more than 1300 journals, some dating back to 1981.
- **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition** includes an index, abstracts and fulltext articles. **Health Source: Consumer Edition** is designed for patient use...not professionals.
- **MEDLINE** provides authoritative medical information from over 5,400 current biomedical journals.
- **eBook Academic Collection** includes books about nursing, health, and related subjects.

Also: Health Reference Center Academic (INFOTRAC) includes an index, abstracts and fulltext articles.

Database off-campus passwords:

For off campus access to the OSU-Oklahoma City Library databases, go to **osuokc.edu/library**, then click on the ‘Online Databases’ option. Log in by following the instructions on the web page. (see ‘Click Here’ at top of page.) O-Key username and password are required for off campus access.

To identify book and AV materials, use ‘Pete’s Portal’ (Library Catalog). Under ‘Books & More’, type in your specific area of interest. Use the facets on the left side of the screen to narrow your search. These materials are shelved by Call Number.
