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Statistics

- 121 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
 - 52% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
 - 48% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

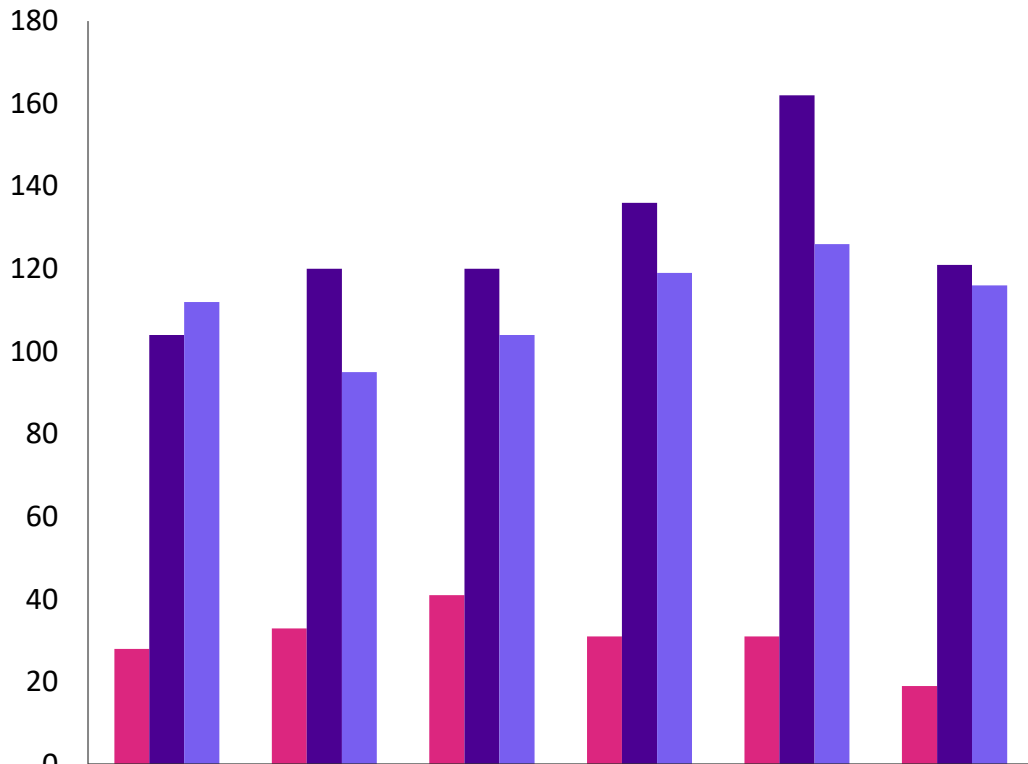
Primary Student Disabilities

1. Cognitive/Learning (36%)
2. Mental Health (30%)
3. Chronic Medical Conditions (14%)
4. Sensory (11%)
5. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (7%)
6. Other (5%)

Student Disability Accommodations Provided

1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes, to be taken in a reduced-distraction setting (91%)
2. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (41%)
3. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (31%)
4. Other accommodations (26%)
5. Captioned media (4%)
6. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (3%)
7. Sign Language interpreters (3%)

Figure 2: Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Disability Accommodations in Fall 2019

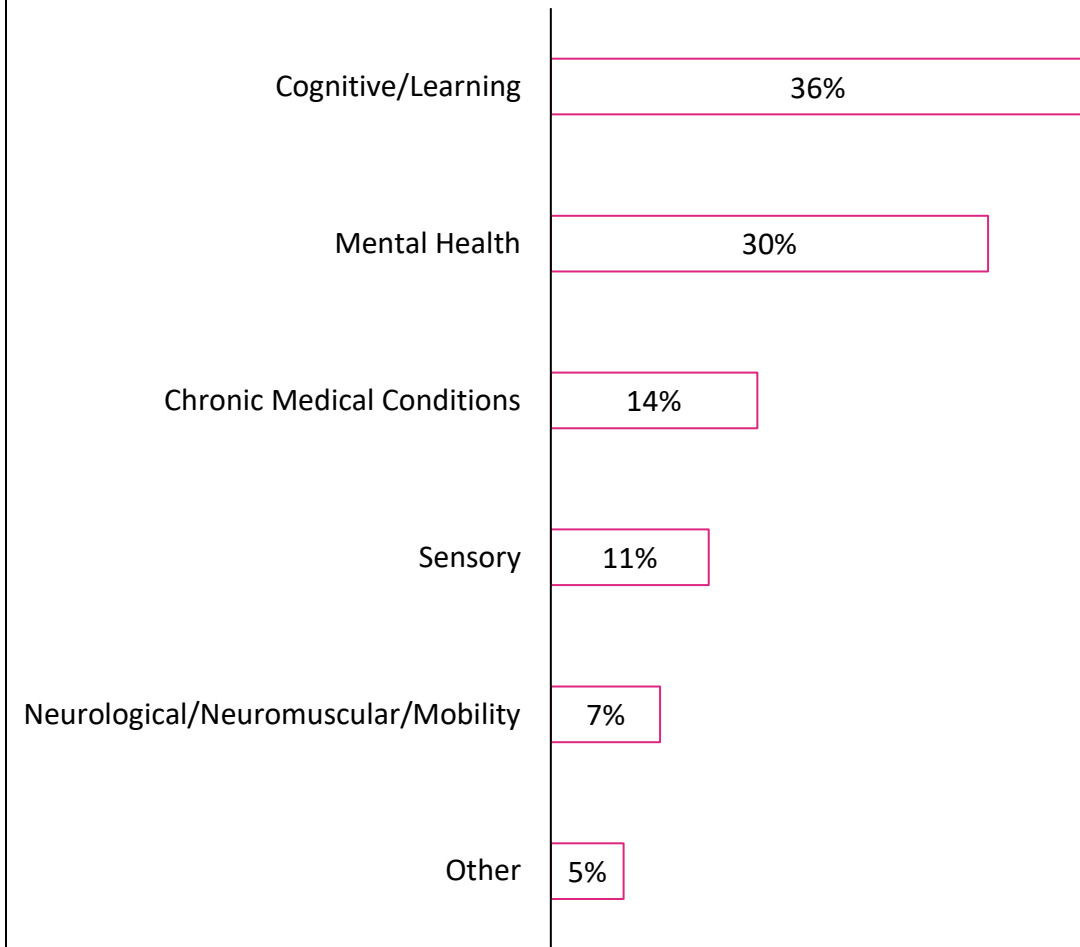


Figure 3: Student Disability Accommodations Provided in Fall 2019
