 - 51% are current/returning students.

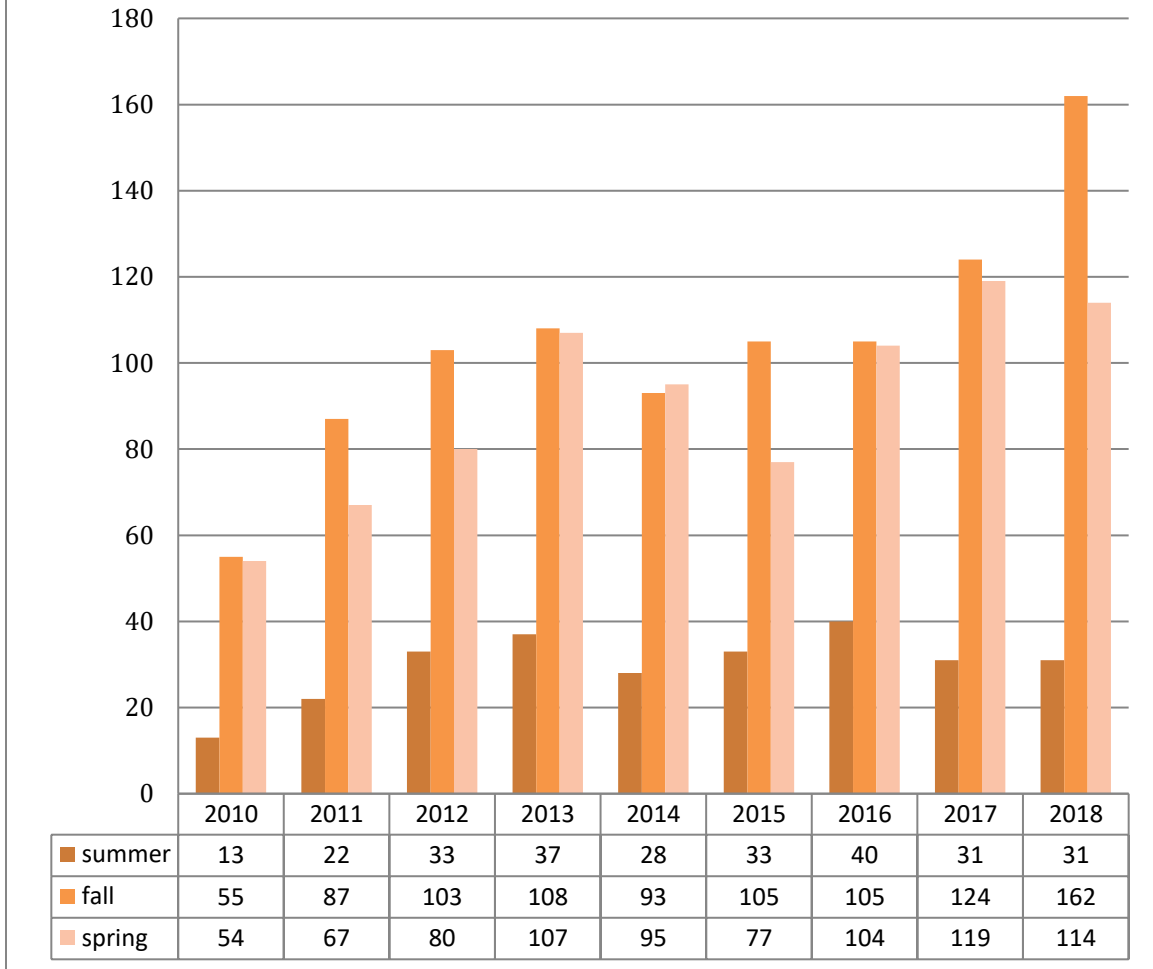
Primary Disabilities

1. Mental Health Conditions – mood/anxiety/psychotic disorders/PTSD
2. Learning Disorders
3. Other – sensory, autoimmune, orthopedic, endocrine, developmental disabilities
4. Attention Deficit Disorders

Disability Accommodations Provided

- Extended time on exams and quizzes
- Permission to audio record class lectures
- Flexibility in attendance policies/coursework due dates/make-up work in case of a medical episode
- Media captioning
- Sign language interpretation
- Reader on exams
- Scribe on exams
- Copies of instructors' PowerPoint slides
- Permission to use laptop in class to take notes
- Note taking assistance through volunteer students
- Use of formula note cards on math exams
- Use of a calculator on math exams
- Preferential seating
- Take breaks as needed during class
- Enlarged print handouts and exams
- Auxiliary aids – loaning digital voice recorders, anti-glare computer screen filters, assistive listening devices
- Access to assistive technology devices and software
- Alternative format textbooks
- Service animals on campus
