**Your submission of this application will consider you for available tuition waivers and/or Foundation Scholarship opportunities available at OSU-Oklahoma City. Final awards will only be made to applicants who have been admitted in good standing to OSU-OKC. Funds are limited so apply early!**

### TUITION WAIVERS:

- OSU-OKC awards tuition waivers of various amounts to eligible applicants who are first-time entering, transfer or continuing students. **Full-time benefit-eligible employees of OSU-OKC are eligible for the Faculty/Staff Tuition Waiver.** Tuition waivers appear as reductions from university tuition charges. Tuition Waiver awards must be accepted within the time frame designated in the award letter or the offer may be rescinded. In addition, waivers must be used the first semester it is available and used continuously, with no breaks in attendance at OSU-OKC, or it will be rescinded.

### FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS:

- OSU-Oklahoma City has a variety of scholarships available through the OSU Foundation. OSU-OKC Foundation Scholarships are available in the majority of the university’s academic divisions as well as other areas of interest.

### FOR CONSIDERATION:

- Apply for Admission to OSU-OKC (New or Transfer Student) before submitting this completed application. Submit this application and required documents by **March 1** for full consideration. Applications received after March 1st, may receive award consideration, pending funds availability.
