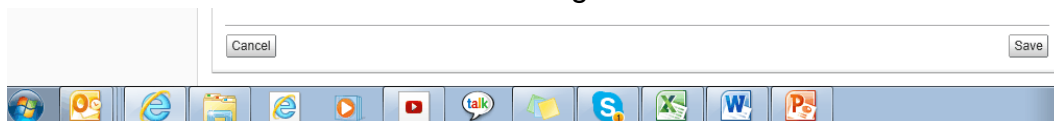


## Step-by-Step Instructions for enabling Plagiarism Detection in D2L

- 1) Log into Desire 2 Learn.
- 2) Navigate to the class in which you would like to use Plagiarism Detection.
- 3) Click on the “Dropbox” link in the menu bar.
- 4) Click on “New Folder” to create a new Dropbox submission folder with Plagiarism detection enabled. Or click on the hyperlink of an existing assignment to edit an existing folder. If you are editing an existing folder, you may need click on the “Edit Folder” button.

- 5) The only difference between a new and an old folder at this point, is that all the information fields in a new folder will be blank.
- 6) Click on the Plagiarism Detection Box (Inset in the large red rectangle above).
- 7) Click on the save button at the bottom right.



- 8) Now share with your students that the “robot” is checking their submissions and that you will catch them. Some students do not understand how little effort it takes to catch plagiarism.
