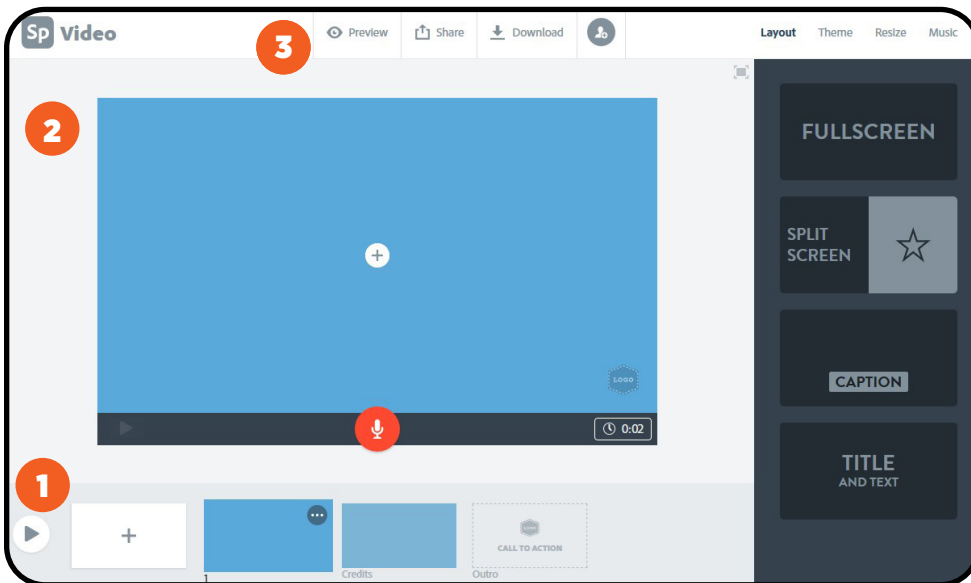

1 - Timeline

- Fig. 1-1*
Click the first square with a plus sign to add a new blank slide to your timeline.
- Fig. 1-2*
Click the three dots above a slide to delete or duplicate a slide, or play your video.

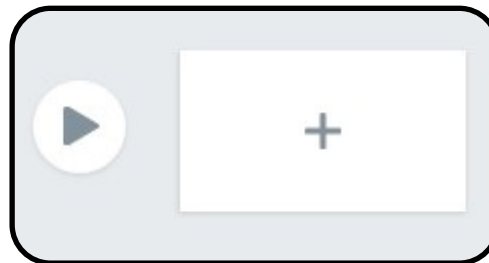

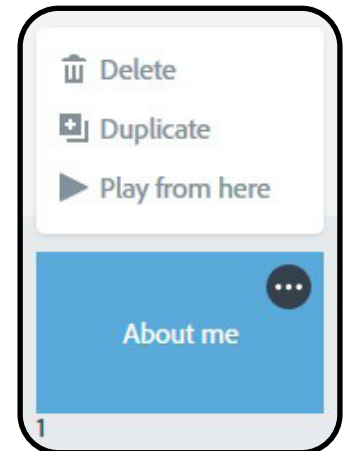

2 - Video Editor

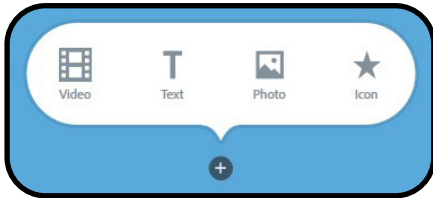


fig. 2-1: Add Content



fig. 2-2: Clip Length

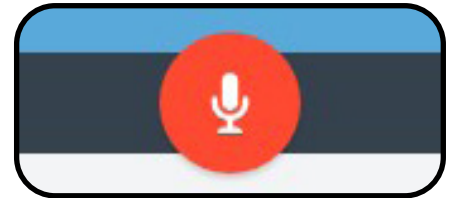


fig. 2-3: Record Narration

2-1: Add Content

Click the plus button in the center of the video editor, and then click Video, Text, Photo, or Icon to add content to your blank slide. The customization panel will appear on the right when you select **photo** or **icon**, search for royalty free images.

2-2: Clip Length

Click the clock button at the bottom of the editor and use the slider to choose the length of your clip.

2-3: Record Narration

Click and hold this button to record audio. The first time, your browser will prompt you to allow microphone access.

2-4: Click and Drag

Click any object you've placed and drag it in the editor to where you want it to appear.

2-5: Customization Panel

This side panel allows you to change your slide **layout**, change the **theme** of your project, **resize** your video, and add **music** to clips. This menu will also appear when you add icons or photos.

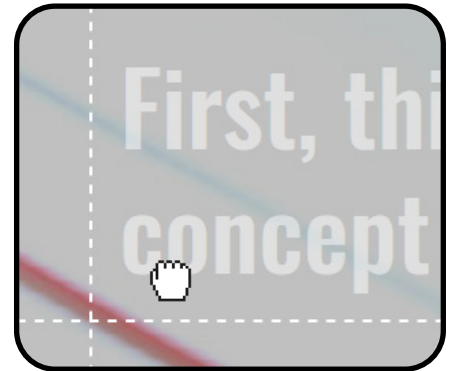


fig. 2-3: Click and Drag

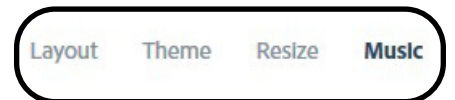


fig. 2-4: Customization Panel
