APPLICATION PROCEDURES
TRADITIONAL APPLICATION

PRIOR TO submitting your Nurse Science Application, the following must be completed:

1. **Be admitted to OSU-Oklahoma City and have a Campus-Wide ID (CWID).** All official transcripts must be submitted to the OSU-OKC Admissions Office OKC.Admissions@okstate.edu by the application deadline.
 - The following courses must be successfully completed with posted grade of “C” or better to your transcript before your application can be considered for the Nurse Science Program: NSCI 1113, ENGL 1113, PSYC 1113, CHEM 1154

AFTER Admission acceptance to OSU-OKC:

2. **Bring, email or mail a complete application and entrance exam scores to OSU-OKC Nurse Science Department.** All documents in this application packet must be submitted at the same time and include the following items:
 - a. OSU-OKC Nurse Science Application Form
 - b. HESI Admission Assessment (HESI A2) exam with a score of 75% or greater
 - c. Documentation of EMT, Paramedic, LPN, AUA or CNA certification for additional points (if not included with application, points will not be awarded)
3. Admission to the program is based on a point calculation system compiled from documents submitted. Due to the high volume of applications expected, it is the student’s responsibility to ensure that all required documents have been received by the OSU-OKC Nurse Science Department prior to the deadline.

Acceptance to the Nurse Science Program may be denied to any student with a criminal history or positive drug screen. Applicants with certain felony convictions may not be eligible to test for licensure. - 3. Submit all official transcripts to Admissions (*Transcripts submitted after deadline will not be accepted*)
- 4. Traditional RN application requirements include:
 - (a) A retention grade point average of 2.5 or higher and a grade of C or better in all prerequisite courses required for the Nurse Science A.A.S. **and**
 - (b) Completion of prerequisite courses (NSCI 1113, ENGL 1113, CHEM 1154, PSYC 1113) **and**
 - (c) HESI Admission Assessment (HESI A2) exam report with a score of 75% or greater
- 5. Drop off, email or mail the complete application packet (including the signed Nurse Science application) to OSU-OKC Nurse Science Department. All documents in this application packet must be submitted at the same time.
