

Traditional Program Application

Admission to the program is based on a <u>point calculation</u> compiled from documents submitted. Due to the high volume of applications expected, it is the student's responsibility to ensure that all required documents have been received by the appropriate department prior to the deadline.

Complete/collect the following:

- 1. Be admitted to Oklahoma State University Oklahoma City (OSU-OKC)
 - a. Apply at https://apply.osuokc.edu/apply
 - i. Submit all official transcripts directly to the OSU-OKC Admissions Office at okc.admissions@okstate.edu.
 - ii. All transcripts must be received prior to the application deadline. (**special note:** Transcripts uploaded to university application portal *are not* considered official transcripts. Official transcripts must come directly from prior schools.)
 - b. You must be admitted to the university prior to the application deadline.
- 2. Have an active student account (OKEY)
 - a. You must list your Campus-wide ID (CWID) on application documents.
 - b. You must communicate via your official okstate.edu email account.
- 3. Completion of the following courses with a "C" or better grade posted to your transcript prior to the application deadline:
 - a. CHEM 1154
 - b. ENGL 1113
 - c. NSCI 11113
 - d. PSYC 1113

Note: While the OSU-OKC Nurse Science Program only gives points for the GPA of the classes necessary for the degree, students must maintain an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher to graduate (Refer to NSP 03.04, OSU-OKC Catalog, OSRHE Policy 3.15.3, A.).

- 4. Accuplacer scores in Reading, Writing, and Quantitative Reasoning.
- 5. Documentation of EMT (any level below Paramedic), AUA, CNA, LPN, Paramedic certification/licensure, previous college degree, or a student returning to OSU-OKC for additional points.
 - a. Please note: If this documentation is not included with the application, points cannot be awarded.

Note: Acceptance to the Nurse Science Program may be denied to any student with a criminal history or positive drug screening. Applicants with certain felony convictions may not be eligible to test for licensure.
