Application Criteria:

- 1) Enrolled in NURS 1118, NURS 1148 or NURS 1313 during the spring semester
- 2) A 3.0 GPA in courses required for the nursing degree
- 3) Provide a narrative of financial need
- 4) Identify personal and professional goals
- 5) Write a personal philosophy of nursing that speaks to the relationship of values, knowledge, caring and persistence in pursuing this professional career
- 6) Submit a letter of recommendation from a current employer or one from an instructor outside of the nursing program

Recipient Criteria:

- 1) Write a thank-you letter and submit to the Scholarship Committee Chair
- 2) Attend OSU-OKC donor appreciation events



Nancy Hall

Nancy Edna Hall devoted her adult professional life to nursing care of the geriatric client. For over 25 years, she worked at Four Seasons Nursing Home. She was very dedicated to the patients and their families.

She began her career with Four Seasons Nursing Home as an L.P.N. and later became the Assistant Director of Nursing. At age 53, she re-entered school to receive her R.N. credential and was the 100,000th student to enroll in Oklahoma City Community College, a fitting honor for her. After graduation she became the company's regional training director and worked in developing an on-the-job training program for nursing students. She was very honored to serve on the advisory boards of several local nursing programs. After this success though, she felt something was missing and discovered it was the personal contact with patients and their families. Because of this, she asked to take the Director of Nursing position at Four Seasons where she served until her death in 1994.

Even after she was diagnosed with cancer, she never stopped giving and caring to everyone she met. In her last days, it was she who consoled others at the hospital. She became an inspiration to virtually everyone that met her.

To honor her for the many years of dedicated service, a scholarship in her memory to be awarded to a qualified nursing student entering the final year of the Oklahoma State University Nursing Program has been set up. This \$2500 scholarship will be awarded at the beginning of the third semester of the nursing program.

Her son, Miles Hall, states that "Nancy Edna Hall believed that great nurses have vision and gave care from their soul. Therefore she worked at the earliest stages of a nurses' training to instill in them VALUES, KNOWLEDGE, STICKABILITY, and PERSONAL CARING. Because of this mission that she believed in, this scholarship is established."
