President's Leadership Class Scholarship (PLC)

The President's Leadership Class Scholarship at OSU-OKC recognizes outstanding students who have demonstrated talent and distinguished achievement in the areas of leadership, citizenship, service and communication. The scholarship is comprised of a full-tuition waiver for up to 15 credit hours each fall and spring semester, including fees and a \$500 book stipend.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Have 3.0 GPA or higher
2. Current college students should be enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours each semester
3. Be actively involved in school clubs, organizations and/or activities (current college students must be active in two campus organizations)

Application Procedure

Scholarship applicants who meet the eligibility requirements must submit the following material with this completed application:

1. Official transcripts from all universities and colleges attended must be on file in the OSU-OKC Admissions Office.
2. Transcripts of recent high school graduates must be on file in the OSU-OKC Admissions office.
3. Two letters of recommendation from two of the following categories below: (additional recommendations will *not* be considered)
 - University/College or High School Faculty or Staff Member
 - Student Organization Advisor or Sponsor
 - Community Leader, Employer, or other Qualified Member of the Community

Students who receive a President's Leadership Class Scholarship also become members of the President's Leadership Class and must attend monthly PLC meetings and designated recruitment and special events. Members of the PLC participate in activities, programs and workshops that enhance their leadership abilities and take active roles on the OSU-OKC campus through leadership positions in a variety of student organizations.

Selection Process

All applicants who meet the specified requirements will be considered by the PLC Selection Committee. The Committee will review the applications and recommend the top applicants for an interview. Students who advance to the interview process and are recommended by the PLC Selection Committee will be considered for awards. *All* applicants will be notified by mail regarding the result of the application process.
