Application Deadline: December 1, 2018

Award Information

Two **\$1000** scholarships will be awarded each spring semester, pending fund availability. The recipients will be selected by members of the OSU-OKC Scholarship Committee, and the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Division.

Eligibility Criteria

- Declared Architecture or Construction Technology major
- Enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours
- GPA – 3.0 or higher

Application Procedure

Applicants who meet the eligibility criteria requirements should:

1. Complete the scholarship application.
2. Write a short essay, 250 words or less, outlining career goals upon obtainment of the Architecture or Construction Technology degree from OSU-OKC.
3. Submit the completed scholarship application to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarship on or before scholarship application deadline. Award notifications will be sent by the end of December.
