<u>Definition:</u> MLA Format is the Modern Language Association's standard for the presentation of an essay, including a <u>header</u>, <u>last name by page number</u>, <u>title</u>, <u>Times New Roman</u>, <u>12 point font</u>, <u>double spaced</u>, <u>1-in margins</u>, <u>and a Works Cited page</u>.

Lesson:

<u>Text:</u> All text should be Times New Roman, 12 point font, and it needs to be double spaced.

<u>Page Number:</u> There should be a page number in the upper right corner of the essay. Your last name needs to appear to the left of the number.

Margins: There should be 1-inch margins all around the paper, except for the page number which should be ½ inch from the top of the page.

<u>Header:</u> The header is to the left of your first page and it includes, in order:

Author - Your Name

Professor's Name

The Class Title

The Date (Ex: 4 January 2023)

<u>Title:</u> The title should be centered on the page after the Header.

<u>Paragraphs</u>: Each paragraph should be indented ½ inch. Do not skip a line at the end of each paragraph.

<u>Work(s) Cited Page:</u> This is the final page of the essay. "Work Cited" for a single citation, or "Works Cited" for multiple citations, should appear centered at the top of the page. Citations follow in alphabetical order, complete with hanging indentions.


