<u>Definition:</u> The writing process is the process by which someone writes an essay, story, or other text. Some guiding processes include listing, brainstorming, outlining, drafting, and revising.

Listing:

Begin by choosing a topic. Set a timer for two minutes and write out as many topic ideas as you can think of, good or bad. Then, when the timer goes off, circle the top three you like the most. From here, narrow it down to one topic for your essay.





Drafting/Revision:

Follow your outline to create a first draft of the essay. Once you have it written out, read it aloud carefully. Listen for mistakes.

Another great way to revise is to print the essay out and ready it carefully, making corrections on the paper with a pen.

It also helps to get a second opinion on your writing. We recommend having a classmate, professor, or tutor look over your essay for you to get advice on what needs revision.
